

Hindustan Motors launches new vehicle

KOLKATA: Hindustan Motors launched VEER, a 0.8-tonne (800 kg) small commercial vehicle (SCV) here on Monday saying that more launches are in the pipeline within this fiscal year.

A change in the product mix is also being planned.

While these vehicles are set to be made from the Pithampur unit, it was learnt that some launches from the

Chennai unit were also on the cards by March 2012.

This may include a sports utility vehicle too.

Manoj Jha, Managing Director, said more launches could be expected from the company.

The vehicle is available in both diesel (BS-III) and CNG (BS-IV) versions and in two models the roll-out starts with east and goes pan-India by March 2012. The inaugural price is Rs.3.30 lakh.
